Objective of WP9

- Objective of WP9: scientific dissemination
- Contribute to the ENDORSE objective of dissemination of its achievements
- This WP is an essential element in the project
=> *All partners should pay the greatest attention to this task*

Usual form of dissemination

- Communications to international conferences
- Articles in peer-reviewed journals,
- Promotional material,
- Web site

Beware that...

- Dissemination activities should clearly refer to the ENDORSE project and the European Union financial support
- For example, articles and communications should mention in the section “**Acknowledgements**”:
“The research leading to these results has received funding from the European Union’s Seventh Framework Programme (FP7/2007-2013) under Grant Agreement no. 262892 (ENDORSE project).”

New forms of dissemination

- Software,
- Web services,
- Interactions with other initiatives and large projects

As well...

- “Any publicity, including at a conference or seminar or any type of information or promotional material must specify that the project has received EC research funding and display the *European emblem*.” Mr. Vermoote
- “Any publicity made by the beneficiaries in respect of the project must specify that it *reflects only the author’s views and that EC is not liable for any use that may be made of the information contained therein*.” Mr. Vermoote
